

SADVA COVID Protocols (2022-02-26)

No changing ends

- Teams will no longer change ends during a match
- The team playing the 1st and 2nd matches will stay at the same end for both matches, as will the team playing 2nd and 3rd
- The toss will only decide the server

Sanitising

- The match ball will be cleaned when the first team reaches 12 points, and again between sets
- The second referee will clean the ball. You can keep the game flowing by swapping the match balls when one is cleaned
- Players are strongly encouraged to hand sanitise when the first team reaches 12 points, as well as between sets

Miscellaneous

- Mouth-blown whistles must not be used. Squeeze whistles are provided in each team box
- There are no pre-post match handshakes. Teams may applaud each other from their own side of the net
